Co-Buddy™ Lone Worker System

The **Co-Buddy™**, system is designed specifically to manage and monitor the safety of staff working alone after hours.

Co-Buddy™ integrates a Scantronic Man Down pendant alarm with the GPS capable Tait Mobile Radio (TM 8200) and the services of a 24x7 commercial security-monitoring centre (Security First NZ).

The system is designed to provide a buddy for staff working alone (after hours or during normal hours) by monitoring their safety throughout the duration of a job.



The unique **Co-Buddy™** system tracks, records and monitors each phase of the job including:

- The time a person leaves their home or base location
- The journey to the job location (GPS tracking)
- The time they arrive at the job
- Their safety whilst on the job (via man down pendant)
- When the job is complete
- And the return journey home



The Scantronic man down pendant provides notification of an incident or injury (need for assistance) either by an individual's manual activation or automatically (i.e. if the worker is incapacitated) via the man down feature in alarm.

Alarm activations are responded to by the 24-hour monitoring centre, who initiates an established emergency protocol to provide immediate assistance to the lone worker.
